








#### Youth Wednesday Night Worship



# N TH<mark>E SPOTLIGHT</mark>: Martha "Marty" Hi

This is the second in a monthly series for the Contact entitled "In The Spotlight," where I interview members of our church who helped bring us to where we are today. You might say they are the bedrock upon which we have continually built our programming, outreach, missions, etc. As Minister of Visitation, I have felt the need to share with the congregation many of the memories our senior members have shared with me.

Marty was born in Pendleton, Indiana in 1928. She attended Pendleton Elementary School until the 5<sup>th</sup> grade, at which time the family moved to Muncie, Indiana. She then attended Muncie Public Schools, graduating in 1946 from Muncie Central High School.

Ball State Teacher's College beginning in 1947. While still a student at Ball State, she took a missionary. employment at Indiana Bell Telephone Company as a Long Distance Operator.

In 1951 upon graduating with a Bachelor of Science in Education from Ball State, she taught girls junior high and high school physical education, along with teaching social studies.

and husband, Forrest "Woody" Hurst, knew each other since elementary school and both attended Madison Street Methodist Church in Muncie, where they were involved in Sunday School and MYF (Methodist Youth Fellowship).

This year they will be celebrating their 65<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary. They have two children, Timothy and Annie, five grandchildren and one great grandchild.

After living in Illinois for a short period of time, they moved to Carmel in 1959 and started attending Carmel United Methodist Church where Marty became very active in what epitomizes our now present Vision Statement of Connecting, Growing

#### and Serving.

For 15 years she taught pre-school. Marty reports that she started teaching Sunday school while in school, high and continued up until three years ago at Carmel UMC.

Over the many years, Marty served for: Trustees. Mission Commission, and



Education Commission, chairman once. She was very active in getting the food pantry off the ground in the early days and continued volunteering at the Food Pantry for many years. She was also active in other areas, including UMW. Marty also was a longtime communion server.

She most enjoyed serving on twelve different mission trips with the church, beginning in 1982 when they built churches in South Texas; traveled to South Carolina with the youth on mission trips; served along with husband, Woody, at Montserrat Upon graduation from high school, Marty attended and Eustatia Island in the British Virgin Islands where a member of our congregation was serving as

> In approximately 1982 she became involved with teaching our Jr. High Youth Fellowship students, and that lasted approximately six years.

In 1989 she accompanied others from the church to Liberia with Operation Classroom. She recalled this was just right before civil war broke out where Then in 1952 she married the love of her life. She thousands were killed, and total devastation occurred to the country.

> She and Woody reside at The Barrington and take part in many of the activities there, in addition to attending worship and Sunday School at Carmel United Methodist.
